## THE TRADITIONAL PASTORAL MODEL

## A PROPHETIC CHURCH vs A PASTORAL CHURCH

### PROPHETIC-CHURCH MAIN FOCUS

- Vision of the city, regional, state, nations
- Becomes aware of the strongholds in the city
- Establish relationships to works with other ministries
- Develops a plan to impact communities and bring reformation (racial issues, nude salons, domestic violence, drug infestations, etc).
- Oversee teams on assignments
- Train & Equip believers to develop their gifts
- Activate believers to grow their potential
- The focus is to launch and deploys, commission and send out.
- Passionate about the Kingdom of God.

### PASTORAL-CHURCH MAIN FOCUS

- Meet the needs of the people
- Care and comfort the broken hearts
- People become dependent on the pastor
- The Pastor IS the “minister” and is always ministering: pastor visit the sick, prays and counsels the sheeps. The pastor is the administrator, deliverance and the one you call if you need something. Pastor attend to the weddings, funerals, baptism.
